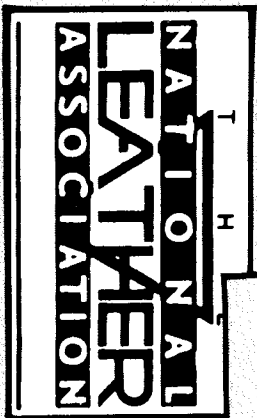
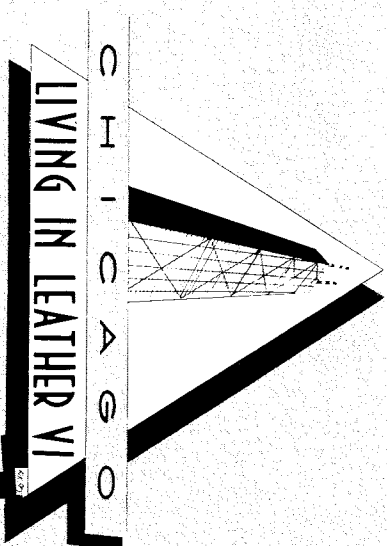

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF THE NLA

To establish and maintain a national/worldwide communication, information, education, and support network for sisters and brothers of the Leather/SM/Fetish community.

To promote with power and pride, the right of all adults to engage in Safe, Sane, and Consensual sexual expression. To increase communication and understanding among women and men in Leather/SM/Fetish.

To facilitate political activism, visibility, and education in order to destroy stereotypes, misconceptions, and media misrepresentation about the Leather/SM/Fetish family in the community at large.

To provide, through our publications, educational material, and LIVING IN LEATHER conferences, a forum for the sharing of knowledge, viewpoints, and practices of a diverse network of women and men.

To build, strengthen, and defend individuals, organizations, publications, and business' within our community, especially against threats to their freedom of expression, freedom to the press, right to free association, and right to equal protection under the law.

To develop outreach to women, people of color, transsexuals, the deaf, the physically challenged, and other minorities who have traditionally been discriminated against or poorly represented in the Leather/SM/Fetish community.

To facilitate fund raising for deserving projects, clubs, organizations, defense funds, and/or charities which have given direct service to the Leather/SM/Fetish community.

To fight for decriminalization of all sexual acts between consenting adults.

To preserve a record of our history, traditions, and culture.

AFFILIATION

Any organization which supports the Statement of Purpose may become an Affiliate member of the N.L.A. Affiliate membership will secure your group a place on the comprehensive calendar published in the NLA *FIRST LINK*, allow discounts for advertising in NLA publications, and allow your group to name a voting representative on the National Council. Dues for non-profit organizations are \$25 per year. Similar benefits will accrue to Commercial members of the NLA (with non-voting membership on the National Council). Dues for commercial members are \$50 per year. Write or call the National Headquarters for information.

CHAPTERHOOD

Any group of 12 or more people can petition for Chapter status. A Chapter must be open to all adults who support the Statement of Purpose of the Association. LIVING IN LEATHER VI

The National Leather Association hosts the annual Living in Leather Conference. The first three conferences were held in Seattle, Washington from 1986 to 1988. Living in Leather IV and V were both held in Portland, Oregon. Living in Leather VI is scheduled for Chicago, Illinois October 10 - 14, 1991. Conferences feature exciting workshops and demonstrations on subject matter vital to our Leather/SM/Fetish family, a vendor's area full of purveyors of goods and services, a showing of S/M and leather related art, social gatherings, political meetings and play parties. Back Door Promotions will produce this year's annual Mr. and Ms. National Leather Association competition as part of the Living in Leather weekend.

At Living in Leather, you will get to meet, and to learn from, many of the most respected, most knowledgeable men and women of the Leather/SM/Fetish community. Our efforts are designed to appeal to all members of that community, regardless of sexual orientation, gender, or degree of expertise. The NLA believes in the slogan developed for the 1987 March on Washington -- Safe, Sane, and Consensual.

The headquarter hotel is the Executive House. The hotel is a first-class property located in downtown Chicago and has hosted events similar to ours many times over the past years.

Registration opens at 4 pm Thursday evening and continues throughout the weekend. The NLA Executive Committee and National Council meetings will be held Wednesday evening and Thursday morning. The General Membership meeting is scheduled for Saturday morning. On Friday space will be made available for special interest groups to meet. In addition to the above, 12 Step (AA and NA) meetings are being planned throughout the weekend. Opening ceremonies will held on Friday, October 11 at 8:00 pm.

On Saturday and Sunday the vendors area and art show will be open from 9 am - 6 pm. The workshops and demonstrations will run from 10 am to 6 pm on these days also. Saturday evening will feature the Mr. and Ms. National Leather Association Contest beginning at 8 pm. The Awards Banquet will be held on Sunday evening at 5 pm, followed by the Afterglow Party beginning at 9 pm. Afterglow entertainment will be provided by members of our own Leather/SM/Fetish community.

Living in Leather VI will be the biggest and boldest conference yet. Don't miss out on the excitement. We hope to see you there.
